

## What is a CPESC?

A CPESC is a recognized specialist in soil erosion and sediment control. The certification program, sponsored by the Soil and Water Conservation Society and the International Erosion Control Association, provides the public with evidence of professional qualifications. This designation is given to specialists who have met established standards of expertise, experience and knowledge.

---

A CPESC must demonstrate through education, experience and examination, knowledge of effective and economical methods of minimizing soil erosion and sediment transport due to land-disturbing activities.

The CPESC program is designed for individuals involved in the following E&SC activities:

- ◆ Development and review of permits.
- ◆ Design and review of E&SC and drainage plans
- ◆ Installation and inspection of E&SC practices
- ◆ Related activities (such as, assisting regulators, authoring handbooks, and educating the public).

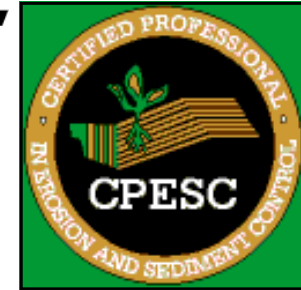

◆ The Review Course is open to everyone and represents a good stand alone educational opportunity.  
**◆ The registration fee(s) for the exam review course is separate from the CPESC application fee.** ([www.cpesc.org](http://www.cpesc.org) for more detailed information)

◆ A CPESC Exam Review Course Manual (required to attend the CPESC Exam Review Course) is included in the registration cost.

◆ The CPESC application process must be completed to be eligible to take the exam. **A CPESC eligibility letter is required to take the exam.**

◆ Visit [www.cpesc.org](http://www.cpesc.org) for more information on the application process. **Please keep in mind that it takes at least 45 days for applications to be reviewed and accepted.** It is strongly encouraged that anyone seeking to sit for the actual exam begin their application process ASAP.

◆ Minimum requirements for CPESC applicants to sit for the exam include meeting the following:

1. Earn a BS degree or higher plus three (3) years of professional level experience in the soil erosion and sediment control profession OR complete seven (7) years or more of professional level experience OR some combination of the two.
2. Four reference letters from erosion and sediment control professionals familiar with your work.

◆ Exam is to be taken within ONE YEAR of receipt of eligibility letter.
